

## NDAA Compliance Statement

---

The John S. McCain **National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA)** for Fiscal Year 2019 was signed into law on August 13, 2018 and effective from August 2020. The law, specifically Section 889, prohibits federal agencies, their contractors and grant or loan recipients from procuring or using "telecommunications and video surveillance equipment or services" from specific Chinese companies. The NDAA ban includes telecommunications & video surveillance equipment produced by Huawei Technologies Company, ZTE Corporation, equipment produced by Hytera Communications Corporation, Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Company, or Dahua Technology Company.

We hereby declare that the products listed below complies with NDAA Section 889 as these products do not use any components produced by companies mentioned above.


